AHS Community Scholarship Application Process

- If you would like to apply, students must:
 - Read through each scholarship opportunity on Naviance to *identify which scholarships are applicable for you.*
 - <u>Submit Permission Form</u> for any scholarships you will be applying for.
 - Download and complete required applications from Naviance website.
 - Create a cover sheet for each application with full name, date of submission, and name of scholarship.
 - Deliver a hard copy of application materials with cover sheet to AHS School Counseling Office ON/BEFORE April 19, 2024.

School Counseling Office will provide scholarship organizations with transcripts and/or letters of recommendation (if required).
